- No refunds unless verified illness or injury to horse or rider. No Alcoholic beverages allowed per bylaws!
- All exhibitors must comply with local, state and federal regulations— Current Coggins papers will be checked at all shows. IT'S THE LAW!
- Helmets are required for exhibitors 18 & under, unless a signed parental/guardian waiver is on file. Proof of rider age may be required if questioned (i.e., copy of birth certificate)
- Appropriate classes may be combined/split upon show management's discretion
- People exhibiting poor sportsmanship, unsafe/illegal equipment or over correcting of equine will be asked to leave
- 1. Open Pony Halter-(Equine maturing at 57" or under) not eligible for 3 or 4.
- 2. Three year old and under Halter (horses or ponies foaled in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)
- 3. Open Stock/Draft Type Halter (Quarter, Appaloosa, Paint, etc.)
- 4. Light Breed/Gaited Halter (Non-Stock breeds like Morgan, Arabian, TWH, RMH, etc.)
- 5. Color Breed Halter (Visually Recognizable or papers in hand)
- 6. Pee-Wee Showmanship (10 and under)- no pattern
- 7. Novice Showmanship (Open to novice exhibitors and youth- Pattern required. See ### below)
- 8. Open Showmanship (Open to everyone-Pattern required)
- 9. Lead-line Equitation-(8 years and under) (lead by exhibitor over 14 years of age) OT Riders ONLY eligible for Class 9 and 10. **No Stallions**
- Walk/Whoa (8 years and under) Riders only eligible for class 9 & 10—Headers allowed, OT. No Stallions
- 11. Open In Hand Trail (2 refusals) OT
- 12. Novice Trail (2 refusals) OT See #
- 13. Open Trail (2 refusals) OT
- 14. Open Ranch Riding (requires forward movement) (Walk, trot and lope—extensions may be called-*no pattern*) Any Western tack/apparel/grooming is acceptable
- 15. Open Ranch Riding (requires forward movement) (Walk, trot and lope—extensions may be called. AQHA Ranch Riding Pattern 1) Any Western tack/apparel/grooming is acceptable

- 16. Open English Walk Trot (Walk & Trot or appropriate gaits)
- 17. Novice English Pleasure (Walk, Trot/appropriate gait and canter required) See ### below) Entry fee discounted to \$3 per entry
- 18. Open English Pleasure (Walk, Trot/appropriate gait and canter required)
- 19. Open English Equitation (Walk, Trot/appropriate gait, canter and pattern required)
- 20. Gaited Pleasure (Walk, intermediate gait & extended gait required) (TWH, Paso Fino, RMH, etc.)
- 21. Pee-Wee Walk Trot (Riders 10 and under) (Walk, trot or appropriate gaits) Spotters allowed OT
- 22. Open Pony Walk Trot (mounts 57" and under) (Walk, trot or appropriate gaits) OT
- 23. Novice Walk Trot (Walk & Trot) OT See ### below)
- 24. QCABHA Members Only Pleasure (Walk, Trot, Lope/Canter or appropriate gaits) OT
- 25. Junior Horse Pleasure (horse 5 yrs. and under) (Walk, trot, lope/canter/appropriate gaits) OT
- 26. Senior Horse Pleasure (horse 6 yrs. & over) (Walk, trot, lope/canter/appropriate gaits) OT
- 27. Open Western Walk Trot (Walk and Trot)
- 28. Novice Western Pleasure (Walk, trot, and lope) See ### below) Entry fee discounted to \$3 per entry
- 29. Open Western Pleasure (Walk, trot and lope)
- 30. Western Horsemanship (Walk, trot, lope and pattern required)
- 31. Light Horse Western Pleasure (Walk, trot and lope) (Non-Stock breeds)
- 32. Optional Gait (Walk and either trot/appropriate gaits or lope/canter) (Two distinct gaits!) OT
- 33. Open Bareback Walk Trot (Walk, Trot/appropriate gaits) OT (NO CHAPS!)
- 34. Open Single Driving (class may be split at management discretion)
- 35. Open Obstacle driving (2 refusals per obstacle)
- 36. Open Driving Cones Timed event (ASTM-SEI helmets must be worn while in arena)

Age of horse or handler will be determined as of Jan. 1, 2020. Stallions cannot be handled by youth exhibitors and are not allowed in Lead-line Equitation.
