

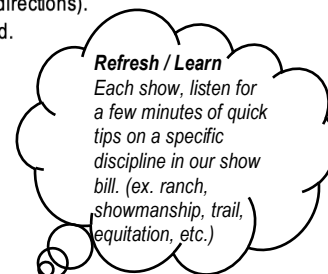

- **Negative Coggins Paper dated within 12 months of the show required: Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds for horses from out of Iowa state. Black Spur for all horses.**
- Participants must adhere to QCABHA rules and to health requirements. Rulebook available at entry booth and online.
- Participants must have their own liability and medical insurance. QCABHA officers and members are not responsible for accidents, thefts, or injuries.
- Horse & handler age determined as of January 1, 2024. Please bring and provide proof of age, if requested.
- Helmets are required for exhibitors 18 & under unless a signed parental/guardian waiver is on file. Helmets are optional for adults in any class.
- Appropriate attire required in all classes except Novice classes. Judge may waive attire requirements due to weather. No tank tops or spaghetti straps.
- Novice (all ages) is a horse and rider team that have NOT won two firsts in that novice class. Ex. Two walk/trot firsts do not exclude entering novice pleasure.
- Appropriate classes may be combined/split upon show management's discretion.
- No refunds unless verified illness or injury to horse or rider.
- Stallions cannot be handled by youth exhibitors and are not allowed in Lead-Line, Walk Whoa or Pee Wee.
- People exhibiting poor sportsmanship, unsafe/illegal equipment or over correcting of equine will be asked to leave.
